

The “NEW” Elite Dance Studio
Health & Safety

Meeting OHA guidelines and additional actions taken by Elite:

- Dancers will enter and exit studios through outside doors only
- Dancers will only be allowed to enter the studio once the last class has left and teacher has completed the cleaning protocol
- Schedule has 15 minute pass time between classes to allow for proper cleaning
- Limited class sizes
- Masks will be worn by teachers. Dancers will have the option
- Lobby and viewing area will be closed to all family and friends and dancers will not have access other than using the restrooms.
- Drinking fountain and vending machines will be turned off
- New hand sanitizer stations located inside each studio door
- Designated place in each studio for dancer’s personal items- i.e. Water bottles, phones
- New floor and barre markings to help maintain 6 ft social distance
- Cleaning supplies provided for teachers- wipes, hand sanitizer, floor mop and masks
- New Signage Displays- Covid Symptoms, Hand Sanitize Here, Proper Hand Washing
- New Antibacterial Hand Soap Dispensers in each bathroom
- All air filters changed prior to re-opening with monthly maintenance scheduled to continue through the year
- Each studio will be equipped with a large floor fan to help circulate fresh air from outside. This will be used between classes, weather permitting and teacher preference

Dancers and Families Responsibilities:

- Monitor dancer’s health at home and do not attend class if showing any symptoms for the last 24 hrs.
- Report possible exposure so we can keep our families informed and comply with state contact tracing requirements.
- Be prompt with drop off and pick up times—remember the lobby will be closed and we will not be monitoring the parking lot.
- Parents may drop off curbside but no stopping or waiting --traffic must keep moving.
- Parents must be in a parking spot for student pick up. This will help keep the parking lot safe and free of congestion. You may use overflow parking at Findley and have your dancer use the crosswalk.
- Limit personal items dancers bring to class. Cubbies will be closed and dancers will be required to place personal items on a marked table in each studio. Minimal personal items means more dance space.
